
IJCAI-2016 SPONSORSHIP AND EXHIBITION GUIDE

Venue

IJCAI-16 will be held at the <u>New York Hilton Midtown</u>, 1335 Avenue of the Americas, New York City. Located in the heart of New York in Midtown Manhattan, this hotel is within walking distance from premier attractions such as Times Square, Radio City Music Hall, Fifth Avenue shopping, the Broadway Theatre District, Central Park, The Museum of Modern Art (MOMA) and many more iconic New York landmarks.

IJCAI-16 will occupy the 2nd, 3rd and 4th floors of the Hilton. The **exhibits and coffee breaks** will be in the Sutton Complex on the second floor.

Scope

Based on previous IJCAI conferences, we expect an attendance of approximately 1200 participants, drawn from the world's top technical universities, research labs and applied industry firms.

The IJCAI technical standards are quite high. Typically, only about 25% of submitted papers are selected for oral or poster presentation at IJCAI.

Exhibitors will have a basic stand space with basic power supply and display conditions detailed below. Exhibitors may expect space to accommodate a 6 foot tabletop.

Exhibitors should express their preferences on stand spaces according to locations depicted in the Floor Plan below.

Basic Exhibitor Stand:

USD 2,000 for commercial exhibitors
USD 1,500 for publishers and nonprofit organizations
USD 1,000 for universities and research institutions

This option includes:


- One table, two chairs and electrical switchboard (1.1kw/220v).
- Poster board (up to 3 feet wide, 6 feet high)
- One-line table-top identifier board with company name
 - 1 ink, company logo not included
- One full registration
 - Includes welcome reception, banquet, coffee-breaks, conference bag and access to technical program
- One exhibitor pass
 - o Coffee-breaks and technical program included

Extra Options (same prices for all exhibitors):

- Additional exhibitor pass (4-day)
 - o Coffee-breaks and technical program included
 - o USD 300
- Visitor pass (1-day)
 - o Includes coffee breaks but provides access only to the exhibit hall
 - USD 60
- Additional 65 square foot space (subject to availability)

Assignments will be made on a first-come, first-serve basis, and only after receipt of the contract form and the corresponding payment, (100% of total cost payable on application).
